

# Director of Coaching – Delta United Soccer Club

## Objective

The goal of the Director of Coaching (DOC) is to improve the quality of Delta's competition soccer program. This will be achieved by creating and implementing a curriculum that will be followed by our players and coaching staff. The DOC will work with the Board on recommended changes that we can implement to improve the overall quality of coaches.

## Qualifications

- Must have a certified USSF National "C" License. If not, should be willing and able to acquire this license within the first year on the job.
- Must have a minimum of 5-year coaching experience at the competitive level.
- Experience directing club activities and managing coaches preferred.

## Skills

- Demonstrated leadership qualities
- Ability to create and execute a vision for the future success of the club
- Excellent communication and dispute resolution skills
- Excellent organizational and time management skills
- Ability to relate to and motivate youth and adults
- Possess integrity and follow ethically sound standards
- Proven computer skills, including ability to use word processing, spreadsheet, registration and website management programs
- Ability to work with a specific budget

## Duties

- Assess and develop coaches and help them plan and implement training sessions
- Instruct competitive coaches through coaching clinics with house and guest coaches
- Recruit and assign qualified coaches in consultation with the Board of Directors and Competition Committee.
- Work with the Comp Committee to place teams in appropriate league flight
- Coordinate outreach programs (camps, academies, etc.) with the goal of increasing the overall size of the Club
- Represent Club at functions, meetings, and events as directed by the Board.
- Coordinate competition tryouts
- Administrative tasks such as comp game schedule
- Other duties as deemed necessary by the Comp Committee.

**Salary range:** \$15,000 - 30,000 per year depending upon experience, qualifications, and completion of objectives
